The scholarship will cover travel and registration costs for one or more recipients to **TISE 2018**, the natural stone industry's premier exhibition and education event, held **January 31, 2018** at the **Mandalay Bay Convention Center** in **Las Vegas, Nevada.** The Natural Stone Scholarship winner(s) will also attend the **Awards Luncheon**.

Attendance at **TISE 2018** and the **Awards Luncheon** offers the scholarship winner the opportunity to gain valuable technical and practical knowledge, meet and network with leading stone professionals, deepen his or her commitment to a career in the stone industry, and explore his or her potential for future leadership.

Funds are made possible through the generous donations of MIA+BSI members worldwide: total donations will determine the number of scholarship recipients each year. Applications will be reviewed by a committee of the Board of Directors and industry veterans.

2017 Application Due July 14, 2017

Scholarship Selection Criteria:

- Applicants must have fewer than five years of experience in the natural stone industry and work for an MIA+BSI member company for at least six months prior to entering and be employed by a member company at the time the award is presented at TISE 2018.
- Applicants must submit an application form and essay detailing their commitment to the natural stone industry, along with a letter of recommendation from their employer.
- Applications must be received by July 14, 2017.
