

The largest building project in the Mayo Clinic's history, the new Leslie & Susan Gonda Building purposely features several natural stones used in the Clinic's existing structures, including Roman Travertine flooring, Crème Pearl wall panels, and Breccia Aurora feature walls to physically and visually link the new with the old. The exterior is clad with white Brazilian Granite in a framework of brilliant, linen-finished stainless steel and set on a base of white marble. Twin City Tile and Marble installed 17 different colors of stone for the interior finishes, 90% of the stone being colored marbles and limestones.
