Natural stonework was incorporated into many areas of this spectacular cathedral, including the altar, baptistery, paving/steps, and crypt mausoleum. Numerous challenges included sourcing for unique stone; size, weight, and placement issues; maintaining circular floor patterns; and the meticulous attention to detail required to match panels in the crypt. Louie Carnevale and Raffaele Giovetti

traveled to Turkey to locate the Rosso Laguna stone for the altar, which is made of an 11,000 lb. piece (the mensa), atop a 4,000 lb. piece (the pedestal).
